ERS Office Visit Procedures – COVID-19

Members of the public attending the hearing at the ERS's Honolulu office must provide verification of being fully vaccinated or if not fully vaccinated, provide a negative COVID-19 test result (taken within 72 hours of the ERS office visit) as a condition of entry.
