Thinking about a 2023 retirement? Here are some important dates

Members or former members who are eligible and considering retirement in 2023 can prepare by knowing the deadlines for filing an application. A retirement date can be the first of the month or on Dec. 31. An application can be filed as early as 150 days prior and not fewer than 30 days before the retirement date.

Here's a list of first and last days to file an application. The ERS must receive an application by the last days listed (not postmarked, if mailed). Applications must be signed in front of a notary or an ERS representative.
